



# 2018 Kenai Peninsula Open

September 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>

**Professional Entry Fee: \$300**

**Amateur Entry Fee: \$150**

Your entry fee includes a 9-hole practice round/skins game (optional gross and net) on Friday the 31<sup>st</sup>, entry into the first Horse Race Friday Evening and 18-hole tournament rounds on Saturday the 1<sup>st</sup> and Sunday the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Excellent prizes will be awarded to the Open Champion, men's low gross and net amateur, and women's low gross and net amateur as well as team payouts. An awards ceremony/dinner will be held after play has concluded on Sunday.

#### Format:

This is an individual stroke play event taking place over 2 days, 36 hole total. Day 1 pairings will be determined by the tournament committee, day 2 pairings will be based on your day 1 scores. Tee times will be determined based on the size of the field, starting between 9am and 11am.

#### Payouts:

There is an open division, gross and net amateur divisions and possibly a women's division if the player count allows.
